TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP

NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY

THE TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER (Forsyth County, NC) of the North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University established a scholarship program in 1986 for students from Forsyth County, NC who will be attending North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University. The scholarship is administered by the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER**, Winston Salem, North Carolina. The scholarship is known as the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP** and the recipient(s) are known as **TWIN CITY ALUMNI SCHOLARS**.

To maintain this scholarship program, the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER, MEMBERS, AND SUPPORTERS** shall send contributions to North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University designated for the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP**.

The first **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARS** were chosen for the 1986 Fall Semester. Thereafter, additional scholars have been chosen annually or biannually as determined by the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER**.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship awarded to an enrolled full-time student of North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University and selected by the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER**, shall be \$1,000.00 (\$500.00 each semester). The amount of the scholarship for a student enrolled less than full-time, but at least (12) hours, shall not be more than \$500.00 (\$250.00 per semester). The scholarship award will be made in the spring prior to the fall semester of the academic year of eligibility. All recipients who maintain a cumulative 3.0 grade point average or better may reapply per the application process. A scholarship recipient cannot receive the scholarship award for more than eight (8) semesters or four academic years. A student who does not maintain a cumulative 3.0 gpa or better, at the end of the academic year, will be ineligible to apply and/or receive the scholarship award for the following fall semester. A recipient cannot receive the scholarship award for more than eight (8) semesters or 4 academic years.

CRITERIA

The scholarship shall be based on academic achievement. The scholarship shall be limited to students who are citizens of the United States; live in Winston Salem/Forsyth County, and have not been awarded a full academic or full athletic scholarship to attend North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University. The scholarship is available to be awarded to three different classification of students (Entering freshmen, Continuing students, and Transfer students)

I. Additional Criteria for Entering Freshmen (Graduating High School Students)

- A. The applicants/recipients must have graduated from an accredited high school or will be graduated from such school prior to the enrollment date of the fall semester of the year for which the selection is made.
 - B. The applicants/recipients must have an academic high school grade point average of "B" or better.
 - C. The applicants/recipients must have minimum combined score of 850 (Math and Verbal) on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or a minimum combined score of 18 on the Admission College Test (ACT).
 - D. The applicants/recipients must provide evidence of acceptance by North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University as a student.
- II Additional Criteria for Continuing Students (Second semester freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors).
The applicant/recipient must have a cumulative 3.0 or better grade point average at end of each academic year.
- III. Additional Criteria for Transfer Students
The applicants/recipients must have a cumulative 3.0 or better grade point average earned from the transferring school.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR STUDENTS

All applicants must provide the following information to be considered for the TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP:

- I. Entering Freshmen (Graduating High School Students)
 - A. Completed application with senior photo attached
 - B. Three references (two from high school instructors and one from a member in the community)
 - C. Official copy of high school transcript which indicates grade point average
 - D. Copy of SAT or ACT score
 - E. Copy of Acceptance Letter from NC A&T State University
- II. Continuing Students (second semester freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors)
 - A. A letter applying for the scholarship
 - B. A certified copy of your NC A&T State University transcript
- III. Transfer Students
 - A. Completed application with current photo attached
 - B. Official copy of transcript from school you are transferring from indicating grade point average
 - C. Copy of Acceptance Letter from NC A&T State University

PROCEDURES FOR SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

The **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE** shall have the responsibility for the final selection of recipients within the eligibility and criteria guidelines contained in this agreement.

1. Alumni, who are financial members of the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER**, may recommend persons to the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE** and will be responsible for assisting in obtaining the proper documentations for the applicants.
2. Students who meet the criteria can also obtain the scholarship application from the chapter, high schools, or website and submit the completed application with all required documentation to the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE**.
3. After receipt of the **applications and required documents**, the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE** will screen those students qualifying for the scholarship.
4. The **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE**, during the regular monthly meeting of the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER**, will present its selection of recipients for approval by the members of the **CHAPTER**.
5. All recipients of the **TWIN CITY ALUMNI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP** will receive notification by mail from the **Scholarship Committee Chairperson**.
6. **North Carolina A&T State University** will transfer the scholarship award into the scholarship recipient's student account at North Carolina A&T State University. Payments will be made in two installments at the beginning of the spring and fall semesters.
